



Q2 What is your main reason(s) for using the library (check all that apply)?






Q9 What day(s) during the week is the best day for you to visit the library?


Q10 What time of day is most convenient for you?




Q12 Do you feel the library promotes diverse and inclusive programming?



Q17 Your gender



Q18 Your age group



Q19 Your education level



Q20 What is your current work status? Check all that apply.


